**CLUB HOUSE RULES**

THE FOLLOWING RULES GOVERN THE STANDARD OF CONDUCT  
EXPECTED OF MEMBERS AND GUESTS WHILE ON BRANCH  
PREMISES:

Bar staff will have absolute authority to enforce these **Club House Rules**, *Liquor Licence and Control Act, 2019 (LLCA)* and *Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario* (AGCO) Regulations.

1. Breach of these Club House Rules may result in administrative action through the Article 3 process for members or deprivation of Royal Canadian Legion Limestone City Branch 560 premises for non-members.
2. The Bartenders have complete authority on the premises and all members and guests will be guided by their instructions. No member shall reprimand, nor interfere with, the bartenders or any staff members. Any Complaints with respect to service or employee's behaviour must be made in writing to the Branch Executive.
3. If suspected misconduct of these Club House Rules is observed, report it to the Duty Bartender immediately and take no further action.
4. No behaviour will be tolerated which interferes with the use and enjoyment of the branch facilities by others. This includes criminal actions, violence, foul language, sexual, racial, and prejudicial remarks or gestures. Participants in such disturbance or obnoxious behaviour may be directed to leave the premises.
5. Persons, whom, in the opinion of the bartender, are under the influence of drugs or alcohol to such an extent that they may endanger themselves or others, will not be served and may be asked to leave the premises. No patron may purchase an alcoholic beverage for any patron that has already been denied service.
6. Patrons causing wilful or negligent damage to furniture or furnishings will be expected to reimburse the branch for repair or replacement costs. And may be subject to administrative action.
7. Any patron asked to leave the premises by the bartender on duty will do so immediately or face administrative action or trespass order.

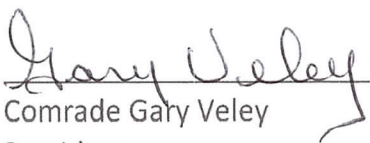
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8. Dress for members and patrons using the premises shall be neat, clean and tidy. No vulgarity or excessive bare skin (Swimsuits) as identified in the Branch Policy & Procedure Manual.
9. The wearing of OMC / Street gang colour is prohibited on branch premises.
10. Headdress for religious or spiritual expression or related to medical conditions is always permitted. Headdress will be allowed for open to the public events such as live music, karaoke, and themed parties.
11. No weapons allowed on the premises.
12. No gaming that is not in compliance with branch gaming licence.
13. No outside food or drink permitted that does not comply with branch food policy.
14. Non-members may be requested to sign in.
15. No person under the legal age as defined by the A.G.C.O, shall be allowed to purchase or consume alcoholic beverages nor participate in games of chance on the premises. Minors must be seated with a parent or guardian and behave in an orderly & supervised manner.
16. Alcoholic beverages not purchased on the branch licence or authority of a special occasion permit will not be permitted on the premises, including the parking lot and patio. All Alcoholic beverages must be consumed on the licenced premises.
17. Rooms when rented are out of bounds to all persons not invited to the function.
18. Animals, except Service Animals on leashes, will not be permitted in the building.
19. Patrons will vacate the premises 45 minutes after bar closure. The Bar shall open during the hours specified by the A.G.C.O, or for fewer hours set by the Executive Committee.
20. Challengers to club house games (Pool, Shuffleboard, Darts, Etc.) must be accepted when their names have been entered on the board. Unless patron has purchased the use of the game for a time duration. All games will be governed by the posted rules.

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21. The use of tobacco, E-cigarettes/vaping, and Cannabis products shall be governed by provincial/municipal regulations and may only be used in the approved areas of the premises. No Cannabis products to be used on the Patio. By law, no use of smoking/vaping product within 9m of any doorway.

These updated Club House Rules were approved by the membership at the 21 January 2025 General Meeting.
